- **Blue:** What freedom or flexibility feels threatened?
- **Red:** What respect, loyalty, or action feels missing?

4. Choose one next behavior

Not “communicate better.” Choose something visible: text if late, schedule 20 minutes, repeat what you heard, decide by Friday.
